13. OUTCOMES & OBJECTIVES ACHIEVED- The objective was to enable students to be aware of application of laws on factual situations in real life scenario. The court proceedings





should be taken into consideration while preparing for career in legal field and thus practical experiences are important for a student. The students were able to make the memorials on their own and learnt so much about authorities, jurisdiction of a court, how to analyse laws and cases and interpretation of law in particular circumstances.

They also learnt to argue in court room in front of judges and how to particularly adhere to court mannerisms.

Students have confidence that they can speak in a manner that will be logically convincing and effective. They can participate in external Moot Court Competition more confidently.

14. OBSERVATIONS - The session was concluded by the Director IPEM, Dr. R.K Singhal with his motivational words who briefly explained the importance of this competition.
15. SHORTCOMINGS- Due to hesitation, for few participants it was a little difficult to speak throughout in English, but with the help of other team members they could successfully present their case.
16. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS- The time for memorial submissions must be at least 15 days after the release of moot proposition because it encourages junior students to take part enthusiastically. Also, during the actual arguments, the collar mic should be given to the participants for clear audibility to the audience.

Initially people were gathered at a place and information were delivered to them. Then legal booklets were distributed and door to door awareness were also given to the villagers by our students
11. **OBSERVATIONS** – Initially, people are not willing to participate in the camp as they have trust issues with our laws. They believed that Court proceeding are time taking and a waste of



money. People are not aware of their basic rights and they have a belief that settling issues outside court is more affordable and less time consuming.

12. OUTCOMES- After spreading legal awareness among the villagers some people showed up for legal advice and discuss their issues also. Women also come forward for legal advice and attentively attend the camp.

13. SHORTCOMINGS – Few participants still did not show up due to their strong disbelief in laws and Indian Judiciary.


IPEM Law Academy has started the initiative of "Activity Based Teaching" to motivate and engage students to learn better.
